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Biography

Dr. Zhao Jian, whose main research fields are the Cognitive and Cultural Basis of Learning, Technology-based Learning, Authentic Learning Theory and Teaching Design, and Comparative Research of International Courses, is a member of the expert group for the development of "Information

Technology Curriculum Standards for Senior High Schools" (2017) and "Information Science and Technology Curriculum Standards for compulsory Education" (in progress) of the Ministry of education. She is the head of Graduate Certificate of International Education (GCIE) Office of East China Normal University. In the past ten years, she has served as the director of the Department of Basic Education and Lifelong Education, and Secretary of the General Party Branch of the Open Education Institute, and is committed to the basic education cooperation and teacher training management. She led the team to develop the training course for international curriculum teachers' certificates, making it the first IBEC in Chinese mainland (International Baccalaureate Education Certificate) University and APSI (Advanced Placement Summer Instruction) University, and had established the training mechanism of international curriculum teachers in China's higher education institutions.

Workshop Title: Bilingual Teacher Professional Development in changing times
