YK Pao School is a bilingual international Chinese school, with over 1600 students from China and overseas. Last year Pao School was named the top bilingual School in China by the Hurun rankings for the third time in four years.

Founded in 2007, the school is a non-profit private institution established in memory of shipping magnate Sir Yue-Kong Pao, the renowned Chinese businessman, statesman and philanthropist. The school offers a unique Year 1-12 educational programme that integrates elements of Chinese national curriculum and international curricula, culminating with the IGCSE in Y10 and IB Diploma Programme in Y11-12, both of which are complemented by core components of the Chinese National curriculum

Pao School's innovative Chinese-English immersion bilingual programme nurtures the whole person - the entire emotional, social, physical, and intellectual being – and prepares students to become engaged and responsible global citizens of the 21st century.

Pao School has three campuses. The Primary School (Years 1-5), located in Shanghai city centre, and Middle School (Years 6-8), Hongqiao Campus, are both day schools. The High School (Years 9-12) located in Songjiang District of Shanghai, caters to both day students and offers UK /US style boarding education.

International Chinese Curriculum Sequence

At YKPS students are responsible for completing the IGCSE and IBDP, and meeting Chinese national standards in Zhong Kao and Chinese 4 Courses (CNC) which focuses on the history,politics,culture,and geography of ancient and modern China, including instruction in traditional writing and arts.

* Grades are determined based on the CAIE and IBO grading rubrics. Students receive a letter grade of A*-G in their IGCSE courses and a number grade of 1-7 in their IB courses.



Outdoor Education

As part of the unique learning experience at YK Pao School, students are given the opportunity to take part in our Zhi Xing China Programme. This is a week of learning and education outside the classroom in which students engage in fun and challenging opportunities which complement and run alongside the school's curriculum, enhancing and building on the lessons learnt in the classroom. The Zhi Xing China Programme provides opportunities to travel to different locations around China so students can experience and learn about the foundations of Chinese culture and history.



Tutor / Peer Mentoring

As part of the Peer Mentoring program at YK Pao School, all dorm prefects as well as groups of volunteer students receive training on basic psychosocial ideologies that will enable them to support the incoming new students to the school and to look out for students struggling emotionally throughout the year. Peer mentoring has been evidenced as having a positive impact on the emotional health and well-being of young people. Peer mentoring can support young people by:


- · Enhancing social competence

IB Results

Over the last two years, more than 200 students participated in IBDP examinations. Notably, 8 students scored 45 points for their IB diploma (the maximum score possible), with the students achieving an average point score of 39 across 2021 and 2022.

In addition, all the students who entered the IB Diploma passed, alongside achieving their Shanghai High School Diploma. Whilst 100% of Pao School students who take the diploma also receive the challenging bilingual diploma compared with the world average of just 28%.
