Designed for children aged 5 to 9, offering a balanced mix of critical thinking, creativity, and physical activity. It aims to develop the spirit of exploration, self-expression, concentration, and innovation in an immersive bilingual environment. The camp introduces the two core subjects 'Bilingual Science' and 'Speak & Shine'(you can choose either one), and two new CCAs 'Creative Arts' and 'Fun Sports,' offering children a summer experience that is at once exciting and educational.



# Course Overview

\*The content of the two sessions is different. Consecutive enrollment is available.

## Core Subject 1: STEM Science

A two-hour daily bilingual environment where the curriculum is centred upon interdisciplinary themes that integrate biology, physics, chemistry, math, mechanical engineering, and earth and space science. It is designed to stimulate students' passion and curiosity for science.



## CCA 1: Creative Arts

With one hour of art lessons every day, the curriculum breaks with traditional teaching methods. Students draw creative inspiration from masterpieces while exploring various artistic expression and materials to develop their artistic imagination and practical skills.

## Core Subject 2: Speak & Shine

A two-hour daily full-English environment, the curriculum integrates the contents of drama and storytelling to enhance students' elocution and expressive power. The engaging and enjoyable classes will encourage their love for language arts and the joy of creative expression.



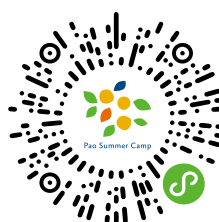
## CCA 2: Fun Sports
