Ningbo, together with international coaches and Pao School teachers, the programme integrates the US Sailing Youth Certification Programme, offering a rich array of experiences including sailing training, evening activities, and a visit to the Oceanographic Institute. With Pao School's renowned camp management, participants are guaranteed a safe, exciting, and memorable summer adventure.



### COURSE OVERVIEW

#### Beginner Class

Built on the US Sailing Youth Certification System, this programme introduces team sailing with the Fareast 28 keelboat (4-6 sailors per boat), fostering teamwork, collaboration, and the courage to face real sea challenges.

Certification: US Sailing Youth Certification

#### Advanced Class

Tailored to each student's sailing level, this programme focuses on Optimist dinghy training, emphasizing independent navigation and on-water decision-making. Students will further develop their sailing skills through personalized guidance.

Certification: CYA Certificate. Students may upgrade to dual certification by taking the US Sailing exam.

#### Admission Requirements for Advanced Class

Students must meet any one of the following:

1. Prior participation in sailing camps or formal sailing training, with foundational sailing skills
2. Holding a recognized sailing certification (including but not limited to RYA / CYA / US Sailing)
